



ANSWERS to questions our members have ASKED

QA

Do I have MASA benefits if I am at home?

Yes! MASA will be there for you if you become ill or are injured and require local transportation by ground ambulance or helicopter, or if you need to be transferred by air ambulance to an upgraded medical facility. Your MASA membership will also get you specialized medical care that may not be available locally.

Do I have MASA benefits if I am travelling?

Yes! If you get sick or injured and require hospitalization, MASA can get you back home for treatment and recuperation. And if you require an air ambulance, MASA will even send a relative or friend with you so you do not have to be alone. Plus MASA membership includes the return of a stranded vehicle back to your home by a bonded driver.

Who decides if I am going to be transported by an air ambulance?

Your attending physician and MASA's medical director determine when and where you will be flown. MASA takes care of all the details and the transportation.

What do I do in an emergency?

If you are in the U.S., call 911 first as you would normally do. Once you are safe and in stable condition, call MASA and they will take care of the rest. If you are overseas, use the emergency services available in your area and then contact MASA.

What happens if I pass away while away from home?

MASA will cover the air waybill for returning a member's remains to the airport nearest the member's permanent address.

When do my MASA benefits start?

Your benefits start immediately once we receive your completed application. Or if you prefer, simply apply over the phone at 1-844-385-4602.

- ▶ **Emergency Air Transportation** – Medically-staffed aircraft are on standby 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year in the U.S., Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean and the Bahamas.
- ▶ **Helicopter Transportation** – MASA will cover emergency helicopter transportation to the nearest appropriate medical facility capable of attending to your needs.

- ▶ **Escort Transportation** – MASA will arrange for your spouse, family member or companion to accompany you in-flight, space permitting.
- ▶ **Recuperation/Repatriation** – Should you and your treating physician determine that recuperation near home is feasible, air transportation will be provided.
- ▶ **Return Transportation** – Arrangements and air transportation for your return home are included.
- ▶ **Visitor Transportation** – A family member may be selected and flown round-trip via common carrier to the location where you are hospitalized for more than seven days.
- ▶ **Minor Children/Grandchildren Return** – Your medical emergency could leave minor children or grandchildren stranded. MASA will provide air transportation back home and when necessary an attendant will ensure their safe return home.
- ▶ **Vehicle Return** – Privately owned or rented cars, vans, motorhomes or travel trailers left unattended as the result of your medical emergency will be returned to your residence.
- ▶ **Organ Retrieval** – Should you need a heart, liver, kidney or pancreas transplant, MASA will transport the organ. Should time or medical necessity dictate, MASA will fly the organ recipient candidate. Restrictions apply.
- ▶ **Pet Return** – A member's dog, cat or small animal can be returned to their residence after a covered medical emergency.
